

WALK 5

Brickfields Park & Manor Park

Distance	1.5 miles
Duration	45 - 50 minutes
Dog Friendly	8/10
Main Bus Routes	14, 15 - Lower Farnham Rd
Notes: During the colder and wetter months it may be advisable to wear strong shoes or boots as it can get muddy and slippery. If the park is muddy this walk may not be suitable for wheelchair users or buggies.	

Starting point: The free car park at Brickfields Park in Boxalls Lane opposite the Post Office.

The route takes you into the park, up the straight path and then veers left or loops right taking you past a small pond.

Continue up a small hill where, at the top, a right turn takes you onto a concrete pathway. Shortly along the path you veer left down Croft Road and Church Lane East into Manor Park.

A clockwise route then takes you to the left following the open park round in a circle before re-joining the same path which takes you back down Croft Road.

In the park is an area of interest where rockery stones have been laid which denote various cities and boroughs which were affected by the Blitz. There is also a statue of Jesus controlling the waves.

On re-joining the alley it forks off into two directions. Take the first left which goes down a gentle paved incline eventually taking you to the corner of Boxalls Lane.

Head up Boxalls lane and return to the Brickfields car park on your right opposite the Post Office.
