

WALK 1

Brickfields Park & Badshot Lea Lake

Distance	1.25 miles
Duration	25 - 30 minutes
Dog Friendly	3/10
Main Bus Routes	14, 15 - Lower Farnham Rd
Notes: The route is off road and good, firm, footwear is advisable. Some of the path is rough and narrow and therefore not suitable for wheelchair users or buggies.	

Starting point: Brickfields Park (free car parking) - opposite the Post Office in Boxalls Lane.

Upon leaving the car park, turn right up Boxalls Lane to the railway bridge. Before going under the bridge, cross the road to the left hand side and turn left down a small track. The path passes Badshot Lea Lake on the left. You may want to stop and observe the birds and wildlife. The path comes out at Lower Weybourne Way where you turn left down the road.

After a short distance the route veers left along a track while the road goes to the right. The track is signposted "Footpath" and runs beside a stream. Continue walking alongside the stream and it eventually joins the Lower Farnham Road next to a car sales company. Turn left.

At the corner of this road and Boxalls Lane there are shops where refreshments can be purchased before walking down Boxalls Lane back to the Brickfields car park. (Alternatively you may decide to join Walk 2 at this point and extend the walk back to your car.)

Why not extend your stay with a visit or a rest in the park before finishing the walk?
