Brickfields Park

Notes: During the colder and wetter months it may be advisable to wear strong shoes or boots for this walk as the park area may be muddy. If the park is muddy this walk may not be suitable for wheelchair users or buggies.

Starting point: The car park by the shops on the corner of Lower Farnham Road and Boxalls Lane.

Follow the footpath down the side of Coronation Road (entrance to the footpath is on Boxalls Lane between Lower Farnham Road and Coronation Road by the telegraph pole). For its duration the footpath is a gentle incline. The path goes across Park Road and Blackman Gardens before arriving at a T-junction with Croft Road where you turn left down the path.

After a short distance the tarmac path continues ahead but you follow the dirt track to the left into Brickfields Park. The route takes you left through the scenic park area round the back of a well stocked pond and picnic area. There is frequently a heron seen perching on the "No Fishing" sign (this area is narrow and rough so you may consider going straight on here keeping the pond on your left). Pick up the wide, long, straight path (with a fence on your left and open green space on your right) down to the Brickfields car park and back out onto Boxalls Lane.

Turn left and it is then an easy walk back to the car park and shops where refreshments can be purchased.
